

Proper Installation Procedures for Dave's PipeStuff



Start above the downspout opening



Cut an **X** through the **GutterStuff**



If the end isn't close cut the **GutterStuff** at a convenient location and lift it out of the way



Remove the downpipe from the eavestrough and disconnect the top pipe strap



Disconnect the bottom elbow and swivel the downpipe down to the ground. The bottom pipe strap will hold it for you while you work.



Insert the electrician's tape (snake) from the bottom



All the other way out the other end



Attach the hook to the Electrician's snake



You are ready to pull **Dave's PipeStuff** through the downpipe



Manually feed the first part into the top of the top of the downpipe



You may find it easier to detach more of the pieces



Once you have it through you can remove the snake and pull by hand

Proper Installation Procedures for Dave's PipeStuff



Pull until you have about 6"-7" left at the top end



Reconnect all the parts



Except the bottom elbow



Swivel the downpipe back into place and manually feed **Dave's PipeStuff** into the bottom elbow and runoff extension



Now you are ready to go back up top



Insert **Dave's PipeStuff** through opening in trough and reattach the elbow



Reinstall GutterStuff and pull **Dave's PipeStuff** through the **X**



Dave's PipeStuff should protrude through and be held up by the **GutterStuff**
